## Pannobile Red 2010

### WINE DESCRIPTION

Top Burgenland grower Paul Achs has been producing Pannobile red since the 1992 vintage. The Pannobile group of winemakers was founded in 1994, and produces top-tier wines reflecting the richness of terroir and character. Each winemaker selects the best and ripest grapes of the local varieties Zweigelt, Blaufränkisch, and St. Laurent (Weissburgunder and Chardonnay for the white Pannobile) all from the best sites. Ach's red Pannobile is matured partly in new barriques, showing charm and style in its youth though it is built to age.

### TASTING NOTES

This dark red wine has aromas of juicy black plum with notes of smoke and sweet spice. On the palate, the wine is powerful, with well integrated, but firm tannins and a good acid structure.

### FOOD PAIRING

Pair with roast beef, spicy short rib sandwiches, or venison.
