"Petits Noizons" is a hillside, South facing vineyard overlooking the village of Pommard.

Dark ruby color. It develops open aromas of fresh red fruit on the nose. It is well balanced with soft tannins and good acidity. The structure nicely enhances the subtle aromas of red fruit, dry roses & leather.
