TASTING NOTES

Nice ruby dark color with violet reflections. Fresh, very soft, and sweet ripe nose of black currant followed by spicy notes of white pepper, fresh tobacco and cedar wood. This medium to full-bodied wine shows elegant tannins. It is already very approachable and will improve with a few years of ageing.
